Program

Care and interventions discussed in workshops:

- Blood sampling,
- Oral injections,
- Deworming,
- Interventions concerning the eyes,
- Rectal temperature measurement,
- Body palpation (ears, gums, ...),
- Measurement (height),
- Placing the foot on a support for a treatment / X-rays,
- Light restraint (halter, work bar).
